Directions:

From I-70, I-40/64:

To Weidman Road entrance:

I-270 South to Manchester Road; west on Manchester Road for approx. 2.5 miles; make a right turn at light onto Weidman Road for .5 mile; Queeny Park entrance is on the right – follow signs to trailer parking.

From I-44:

To the Mason Road entrance:

I-270 North to Manchester Road; west on Manchester Road for approx. 2.0 miles; make a right turn at light onto Mason Road for 1 mile; Queeny Park entrance is on the left – follow signs to trailer parking.

Rules and Regulations

- 1. Except where otherwise noted, USEF/USDF and MHSA rules will apply
- 2. CRUELTY to or the abuse of a horse by any person at a member show is forbidden, constitutes a violation, and renders the offender subject to penalty. The competition committee shall bar violators from further participation for the remainder of the show.
- 3. No Braiding Necessary
- 4. Informal attire allowed. All riders must wear hard hats or competition-appropriate headgear. Paddock boots and half chaps are allowed.
- The 2007 USEF Dressage tests will be used for all classes except Intro classes, which will use 2007 USDF Introductory test. USEF tests are available for download in PDF format from the web at

http://www.dressageamerica.com/dressage_tests_new.htm

- 6. The eventing dressage test can be found as www.useventing.com
- 7. MAIDEN HORSE classes are open to **horses** which have never won a blue ribbon at the specified level at a USEF, or USDF recognized show.
- 8. MAIDEN RIDER classes are open to **riders** who have never won a blue ribbon at a specified level at a USEF, or USDF recognized show.
- 9. In classes15, 16. 17, 18 and 19, more than one test may be ridden but each test will carry a separate fee. State test(s) to be ridden on entry form. Classes will be split if entries permit.
- 10. All test to be ridden in a plain snaffle except Third Level or above, where full bridle is optional.
- 11. Awards through sixth place for all classes.
- 12. A negative Coggins test, dated within one year, must be submitted with entry and must accompany each horse arriving on the grounds.
- 13. RIDE TIMES: Call Christy at 636-561-1457 or check the web site at www.Qpee.org
- 14. Dogs must be kept on a short leash.
- 15. No concessions on show grounds; easy access to restaurants in the area
- 16. No entries accepted after closing date without permission of secretary
- 17. NOTE REFUND POLICY: Entries may be cancelled for any reason prior to midnight on the closing date. AFTER MIDNIGHT ON CLOSING DATE NO REFUNDS FOR ANY REASON!!!

STABLING is not available.

ARENA: The ring will be set on grass. Small arena ($20m \times 40m$) for classes 1-8 and 17-19, standard ($20m \times 60m$) arena for classes 9-16. Schooling will not be allowed in the competition arena prior to the beginning of the show. Horses will be allowed in the competition arena during their warm-up immediately preceding their scheduled times.
