

Premiums will be awarded on the Danish System for classes judged on the exhibitor (showmanship, horsemanship and equitation): Blue \$12.00, Red \$9.00 & White \$7.00. Ribbons will be awarded to the first 5 places in each class. High point awards will be given for each division, Novice, 13 & under and 14 & older.

Riders may only compete in one division for the entire show. Novice riders may not lope in any class & will be disqualified for doing so.

Novice riders are those in their 1st $\,$ or 2nd $\,$ year of competition.

All horses must be checked-in between 10:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. Any 4-H or FFA member in good standing from Callaway County or a reciprocating county who is enrolled in the Horse Program is eligible to participate.

All exhibitors are required to wear their entry number in all judged classes and have appropriate attire and tack for each class. Any exhibitor without appropriate attire may be excused from the class. In case of extreme heat, long sleeved shirts and chaps may be optional at judge's discretion.

Helmets can be worn in any class.

ASTM helmets are required for all speed events and English classes for all participants. Rider will be disqualified if helmet is not worn and properly fastened while in the arena.

4-H exhibitors must show completed 4-H enrollment form including negative Coggins.

All coaching must cease when rider enters the arena. Sideline/rail coaching will not be tolerated and will result in rider disqualification.

Green Horse classes shall be limited to horses in their first year under saddle and shall be walk trot only. Horses shown in green classes cannot be shown in any other class under saddle.

Not responsible for accidents, losses or injury.
