No pre-entries. **AQHA rules will apply at the judge's discretion.** Additional rules and regulations are posted on-line and will be posted at the show. All exhibitors must be 4-H or FFA members in good standing in their county or club. **4-H/FFA horse enrollment forms** with dated proof of membership in good standings will be required at the time of entry. **Proof of negative coggins tests are required.**

High Point & Reserve High Point Horse & Rider (one rider & one horse team) awards given in: Walk-Trot, 13&U, and 14&O.

High Point/Reserve High Point Rider will also be awarded to exhibitors in each division who have shown multiple horses.

Those that run for this award are NOT in the running for a High Point or Reserve High Point Horse & Rider award.

Ribbons will be awarded to the **Top 5** places in each class.

- To qualify for a high point award, exhibitors must **nominate** themselves when entering. They must choose which award they want to be in the running for: High Point **Horse & Rider** or High Point **Rider**. (You may **NOT** receive both a High Point **Horse & Rider** award and the High Point **Rider**.)
- Class #17, 42, and 43 will **NOT** contribute to any High Point Award.
- To qualify for a High Point/Reserve **Horse & Rider** or the High Point/Reserve **Rider**, the exhibitor **must show in showmanship**. Points earned in "All Ages" or "Ponies" classes contribute towards your High Point age Category, unless specified. (See addition rules & regulations for more information)
- **WALK-TROT** may **NOT** enter classes that lope. Walk-Trot is "recommended" for exhibitors in their 1st or 2nd year of the horse project and have not won a ribbon at the Missouri State Fair 4-H/FFA Horse Show.
- **NO STALLIONS.**

***Properly fitted ASTM and SEI certified helmets will be required for all events in classes 17, 18, and 34-44. A rider will be disqualified if the helmet is not on the exhibitor's head and fastened for the entire time the exhibitor is in the arena.**
