The Best of Show Buckle is donated by the Zach Haskins Memorial Best of Show winner is selected by the judge and all decisions of the judge are final The winner is not

picked on high point, but the judge will look at horsemanship, riding ability,

sportsmanship, and any qualities the judge deems important.

Late entries will be accepted up until June 10th, but MUST be accommodated by a \$10 late fee per exhibitor. The fair is July 6th-9th this year and is located in Neosho, MO. \*\*\*YOU DO NOT HAVE TO RESIDE IN NEWTON COUNTY TO ENTER THE FAIR!\*\*\*

Out of county entries for the YOUTH SHOW held on Thursday and Friday July 7 & 8 are \$7/class. ONLY YOUTH ages 8-21 may enter this portion of the fair. We have premiums of \$20-1st, \$17.50-2nd, \$15.00-3rd, \$12.50-4th, and \$10.00-5th for EACH CLASS. Typically, there are add-ons and the check you receive in the mail is more. We also give away 5 high point buckles (one for each age group) and 5 Reserve High Point Trophies. Our best of show (picked by the judge) last year received a buckle and over \$800 in cash and prizes. Entries in the youth show during the week MUST stall their horses on the premises during the fair. Check-in is Wednesday July 6th and horses MUST REMAIN ON THE GROUNDS (unless special permission is made in advance by show superintendent) until Saturday July 9th at 9:00 pm, when you may be released by superintendent.

We also have a showdeo on Friday night where we award 4 High Point Buckles and 4 Res. High Point Trophies. There are not any premiums awarded for these classes. You must have an exhibit in the fair (doesn't have to be a horse in the horse show) to be able to enter the showdeo. You may choose to use a different horse for the showdeo. If you choose to ride another horse for the showdeo, this horse MAY NOT be stalled on the grounds during the week of the fair, due to lack of space and may be hauled in the evening of the show. \*\*\*HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR THE SHOWDEO!\*\*\*

We also have an open horse show on Saturday that is open to all ages. Open show entries are taken the day of the show and may be canceled due to inclement weather, so call before you haul.
