General Rules and Guidelines

- 1. The Plattsburg Saddle Club will host 3 shows July 14th, July 21st, and August 4th. These shows will begin promptly at 5:00 p.m., registrations will begin at 4:00 p.m.
- 2. Our shows will be open to all breeds of horses, ponies, and mules. They are allowed to show in any of the listed classes.
- 3. All horses must have proof of current (within 12 months) negative Coggins Test at each show. Please show papers to show staff at registration.
- 4. Ages of all riders are as of January 1st of the current year.
- 5. All exhibitors, or their legal guardian, must sign a waiver of release found on the registration form at each show. All exhibitors participate at their own risk.
- 6. The Plattsburg Saddle Club is not responsible for any accidents, thefts, or escapes.
- 7. For safety purposes, any horse, pony, or mule that is disrupting a class may be asked to be excused based on the judge and/or ring master's discretion.
- 8. All non-timed events are asked to wear show attire.
- 9. Leadline 6 and under participants may not compete in any other class except Costume.
- 10. Ranch Horse Rail Pleasure is defined as: Horse must have a natural mane and tail. No banded manes or manes shorter than 5 inches. No fake tails allowed. Working ranch type tack is the preferred gear. Any silver that has a working function is allowed. (Examples: saddle conchos, rear billet dees, silver bits, and spurs) Any ornamental silver is prohibited. The judge may ask for a walk, jog/extended jog, lope/extended lope, and the required back. Natural headset and free flowing gaits are the standard for the Ranch Horse class.
- 11. Any issue not covered by the Plattsburg Saddle Club rules and guidelines will be addressed through AQHA rules.
- 12. Show bill is subject to change.
- 13. The Judge's decision is final.
- 14. AWARDS: Each show hosted by the Plattsburg Saddle Club, will present high point awards to the winner in each age division in Performance and Games. Open classes do not count toward high point awards. Points are based on a horse and rider combination. Failure to nominate and pay associated fees before participating in a class will result in the points not counting.
- **15.** The point systems will be as follows:

1 st : 4	2 nd : 3	3 rd : 2	4 th : 1

16. Each class winner in places 1-4 will either receive a trophy for 1st, or a ribbon or medal in places 2-4.
