- 9. Youth Walk-Trot(13-18 yrs)
- Open English Pleasure—English tack/attire required
- 11. PeeWee Youth Poles (18 & under)
- 12. Adult Poles (Riders 19 & over)

- 1. No riding of stallions by youth exhibitors on grounds during show. 2. Ponies 56" & under measurement must be taken & entered on file prior to showing. 3. No entering ring at a run for any class. 4. Disqualification: Hitting in front of saddle. 5. Five second penalty for each barrel knocked down, two second penalty for each pole knocked down. 6. Three minute tack changes must be registered for classes two classes prior. 7. Judges decisions are final. 8. Proper attire and boots required for all classes. 9. Horse/Rider must be registered for classes two classes prior. 10. No cross entering in any halter class. 11. Age requirement as of Jan1.
