All judges' decisions are final! AQHA & ARHA rules will be used at the judge's discretion. Kaysinger Horse Show Circuit rules will supersede AQHA rules.

All horses must have a <u>Current Coggins</u> upon entering the grounds/checking in at the show. All out-of-state horses must have a Health Certificate within 30 days of the opening date of the show, September 13.

Exhibitors 18 and Under may NOT show or handle stallions.

The fairgrounds does not permit dogs on the premises unless they are on a leash.

HELMETS

*AQHA Helmet Rules apply. ASTM and SEI Certified helmets are required in all English Classes 18 and under. **Helmets are required for 18 and Under speed events!

Versatility Classes – You may have no more than two helpers in the arena. Three minutes will be given to change from English to Western attire.

During speed events, riders are NOT permitted to run through the gate. Once they get in and the gate is closed, then they can run.

Awards to be given out: Buckles are awarded to each high-point champion!

High-point awards are calculated on a one horse-one rider combination. 100% classes will be non-point classes. We will also have drawings for raffle prizes.

Lead-line participants may cross to Walk/Whoa classes. One adult may be in the ring with the Walk/Whoa participant. No entry fee for Lead-Line. All entries in Lead-Line will get a prize. Walk/Whoa may not cross-over to Walk/Trot.

Rider may enter one horse in Walk/Trot and one in Walk/Trot/Canter, horse rider/combo cannot cross over! Cross-Over will be allowed between Pleasure classes and Ranch classes.

Each exhibitor's age as of January 1, 2024, shall be the age division they are entered into.

Entrants, participants, employees, spectators, and all others entering the show grounds do so at their own risk. The officers, management, members and/or employees of the Kaysinger Horse Show Circuit, Missouri Showdown or The Missouri State Fairgrounds will not be responsible for personal injury or any loss, damage, or injury to animals and personal property.
