2005 SHOWBILL SUPPLEMENT

GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. ABRA Rules shall apply to all ABRA classes and to ALL Working Ranch Horse and Working Cow Horse classes.
2. OPEN (all breed) classes will be conducted according to AQHA rules (except as noted in #1 above), however horses will be judged according to their breed standards (Arabian, Miniature, Fox Trotter, etc.).
3. H.A.B.H.A. membership is not required except as noted below regarding payback classes & year-end awards.
4. All classes will be judged, regardless of number of entries. H.A.B.H.A. reserves the right to split or combine classes.
5. 2-Year-Old horses shown in Longe Line and/or In-Hand Trail may not be ridden in ANY class at the same show.
6. There will be a one (1) minute gate call. Please inform office or ring-steward of time needed for tack changes.
7. All dogs must be kept on a leash. NO LOOSE DOGS!
8. Current negative Coggins (within 1 year) is required for all horses on the show grounds.
9. Current health certificate is required for all out of state horses.

PAYBACK FUTURITIES & JACKPOTS - \$35 Entry Fee – 75% Payback – Enter day of show

The following classes will be held in addition to our regular schedule and are open to all breeds. It is not necessary to enter any other classes at the show, however all other fees will apply (stall, tie out, office, cattle, shavings, etc.) Enter these classes by listing the appropriate class number (with following letter) on the regular entry form. Minimum of three (3) entries are required for the class to be held. H.A.B.H.A. membership is required for the all owners and exhibitors of horses in payback classes.

All payback classes, except timed events, will be double-judged, with placings combined to determine the final placings. Tiebreaker judge will be determined prior to the show. Checks will be mailed within two weeks to the owner at the address provided all show tab expenses, including H.A.B.H.A. memberships, have been paid. NO POINTS toward weekend or year end awards will be earned in these classes.

Qualifications for YEAR END AWARDS

1. Owner and all exhibitors of a horse must be current H.A.B.H.A. members. Points will not begin until membership is paid.
2. Points will be awarded based on the placings under each judge.
3. No points will be awarded for Payback Jackpot and Futurity classes.
4. Four (4) hours must be worked throughout the year for EACH horse. Owner, exhibitor or designated person may work in the office, at the gates, with the arena crew setting up classes, as ring steward, handing out ribbons, announcing, etc. Each person must sign in and out at the office. Or, a "Work Waiver" fee of \$50 per horse may be paid no later than the final show of the year.

YEAR END AWARDS - Presented at Annual Banquet

Individual Classes - Must show in the class at no less than four (4) shows. Each day counts as one show.

Cattle Classes - Must show in the class at no less than two (2) shows.

All Around ABRA Youth (most points in ABRA Youth Classes)

All Around OPEN Youth (18 & under - most points in OPEN Classes)

All Around ABRA Amateur (most points in ABRA Amateur Classes)

All Around Open Non-Pro Exhibitor (most points in OPEN Non-Pro Classes)

All Around ABRA Exhibitor (most points in ABRA classes except Amateur & Youth)

All Around OPEN Exhibitor (19 & over - most points in OPEN classes except Non-Pro)

ABRA Horse of the Year (must earn points in at least one (1) ABRA halter and three (3) ABRA performance classes)

OPEN Horse of the Year (non-ABRA horse; must earn points in at least one (1) halter and three (3) performance classes)

SUPER HORSE (must earn points in at least one (1) halter, four (4) performance, one (1) cattle classes)
