ABRA & ALL-BREED SHOWS 2006 SHOW RULES & INFORMATION

GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. ABRA Rules shall apply to all ABRA classes and to ALL Working Ranch Horse
2. AQHA Rules & Patterns will apply to all Working Cow Horse classes.
3. ALL-BREED classes will be conducted according to AQHA rules (except as noted in #1 above), however horses will be judged according to their breed standards (Arabian, Miniature, Fox Trotter, etc.).
4. H.A.B.H.A. membership is not required except as noted below for Futurities, Jackpots and Year-End Awards.
5. All classes will be judged, regardless of number of entries. H.A.B.H.A. reserves the right to split or combine classes. This rule does not apply to Jackpot or Futurity Classes as noted below.
6. 2-Year-Old horses shown in Longe Line and/or In-Hand Trail may not be ridden in ANY class at the same show.
7. There will be a one (1) minute gate call. Please inform office or ring-steward of time needed for tack changes.
8. All dogs must be kept on a leash. NO LOOSE DOGS!
9. Current negative Coggins (within 1 year) is required for all horses on the show grounds.
10. Current health certificate is required for all out of state horses.
11. All horses will be issued a permanent number which is to be properly displayed by all exhibitors of the horse at all shows.

PAYBACK FUTURITIES & JACKPOTS - \$35 Entry Fee – 75% Payback – Enter day of show

The following classes will be held in addition to our regular schedule and are open to all breeds. It is not necessary to enter any other classes at the show, however all other fees will apply (stall, office, cattle, shavings, etc.) Enter these classes by listing the appropriate class number on the entry form in the boxes labeled "JACKPOT & FUTURITY CLASSES". Minimum of three (3) entries are required for the class to be held. H.A.B.H.A. membership is required for the all owners and exhibitors of horses in payback classes.

All payback classes, except timed events, will be double-judged, with placings combined to determine the final placings. Tiebreaker judge will be determined prior to the show. Checks will be mailed within two weeks to the owner at the address listed on the entry form provided all show tab expenses, including H.A.B.H.A. memberships, have been paid. NO POINTS toward weekend or year-end awards will be earned in these classes.

Qualifications for 2006 YEAR END AWARDS

1. Owner and all exhibitors of a horse must be current H.A.B.H.A. members. Points will not begin until membership is paid.
2. Points will be awarded based on the placings under each judge.
1st = 6 pts 2nd = 5 pts 3rd = 4 pts 4th = 3 pts 5th = 2 pts 6th = 1 pt
Grand Champion = 2 pts Reserve Champion = 1 pt
3. No points will be awarded for Payback Jackpot and Futurity classes.
4. Six (6) hours must be worked throughout the year for EACH horse. Owner, exhibitor or designated person may work in the stall barn checking in horses and supplying shavings; in the office, at the gates, with the arena crew setting up classes, as ring steward, handing out ribbons, announcing, etc. Each person must sign in and out at the office in order to receive work credit;
Or, a "Work Waiver" fee of \$75 per horse may be paid prior to the horse's first show of the season;
Or, \$100 collected from Sponsors turned in prior to the horse's second show of the season.

YEAR END AWARDS - Presented at Annual Banquet

Individual Classes - Must show in the class at no less than four (4) shows. Each day counts as one show.

Cattle Classes - Must show in the class at no less than two (2) shows.

All Around ABRA Youth (most points in ABRA Youth Classes)

All Around All-Breed Youth (most points in ALL BREED Youth Classes)

All Around ABRA Amateur (most points in ABRA Amateur Classes)

All Around All-Breed Non-Pro Exhibitor (most points in ALL BREED Non-Pro Classes)

All Around ABRA Exhibitor (most points in ABRA classes except Youth & Amateur)

All Around All-Breed Exhibitor (most points in ALL BREED classes except Youth & Non-Pro)

All Around ABRA Horse (must earn points in at least one (1) ABRA halter and three (3) ABRA performance classes)

All Around All-Breed Horse (non-ABRA horse; must earn points in at least one (1) halter and three (3) performance classes)

YEARLING TRIPLE CHALLENGE

Champion & Reserve Champion will be awarded to the yearlings earning the most total points in Yearling Halter, Yearling Longe Line and In-Hand Yearling Trail throughout the season. Points earned in ABRA and ALL-BREED classes WILL NOT be combined.
