Stallions MUST be stalled - May NOT be shown by anyone under the age of 19.

ASTM Helmets required for ALL riders in class 17 & for all riders 18 & under in Speed Events—No Exceptions!

Helmets are recommended for all riders.

Regulations/ Rules For Participants and Spectators

Please read carefully. The premise's owner/ leasee does not guarantee your safety.

We hope you will enjoy the show. Please be happy and safe!

- Age of exhibitor is determined as of January 1, 2007.
- Exhibitors not displaying a entry number will not be placed.
- Current Negative Coggins Required for Horses to be on Property – No Exceptions! The state requires all horses that are being transported to have a current Negative Coggins certificated with the horse at all times. Proof of a current negative Coggins Test will be mandatory for ALL horses entering the grounds. Lone Star may request proof and it must be provided.
- Stallions MUST be stalled
- Please try to park your trailer to allow as many trailers in the parking area as possible.
- All passenger vehicles and trucks without trailers are to park in designated parking area.
- Please be sure chairs are not in the path of moving horses.
- Please do not stand next to the arena with your horse. Do not ride next to the arena if there is a class going on, be considerate of the exhibitors in the arena.
- Dogs are not allowed.
- Small children must be under the direct supervision of a parent or guardian. Do not allow children to approach horses without the consent of the owner. Parents are responsible for the activities of their children while on these premises.
- Owners are responsible for their horses at all times.
- If your horse may kick, please obtain a red ribbon at the Entry stand.
- Warm up times before the show and during breaks will be organized. Lunge liners only will be allowed in the center of the arena. All horses will go the same direction with reverses announced. NO Galloping!
- Horses are NOT PERMITTED TO CANTER/LOPE other than within the arena during breaks. Horses are to be kept at either a walk or trot at all times while outside the arena.
- The show committee will try to provide a warm-up area depending on ground conditions. If there is a warm-up area, please be considerate of others in the area. NO Galloping! Please warm up and then leave the area for others to warm up.
- Horses that the horse show committee deems unruly or dangerous to the exhibitor, other horses or exhibitors will be excused from the arena.
- The show committee reserves the right to refuse entry to anyone or any horse.
- We strongly urge all participants, especially youth to wear protective certified equestrian riding helmets.
- Please dismount from your horse before approaching the Entry/ Announcer Stand.
- Keep within the perimeter of the fenced area.
- Please note the displayed sign concerning Missouri law regarding equine activities.
