

- Ribbons will be given to top 5 places in each class. High point trophies will be given to the Walk-Trot, 13 and under, and 14 and over categories.
  - Points earned in All ages and Novice Classes will count towards your High Point category.
- Properly fitted ASTM and SEI certified helmets will be required for all speed events. A rider will be disqualified if the helmet is not on the exhibitor's head and fastened for the entire time the exhibitor is in the arena.**
