

Like a challenge for your horse? De-spooking your horse clinic - Aug. 1st

Do you know what your horse would do if a group of teenagers thought it was funny to pop their balloons on the float right in front of you? How about loud things zipping around or children running at you screaming while you try to look calm and composed? Pasture buddies don't like to be separated? – Try putting a moving train between them during a parade. Sometimes it almost feels like you are riding in an extreme race obstacle course. These are just a few of the dangerous things that have happened to us during events. We have learned from past experiences that many things can and do happen at events that our horses (and the riders) just aren't prepared for. Although we don't have a moving train available, we'll try to recreate some scenarios with our horses and also discuss action plans so we aren't the ones laying face down on the ground during events.
