Location: Scott Pavilion, indoor arena, west side of the American Royal Complex, 1701 American Royal Dr., Kansas City, MO 64102
Fees: \$5 per class, \$10 office fee for each horse/rider combination. Each participant must have a back number from the check-in table.
Stalls: Available on a limited basis. \$15 per stall. Pre-pay for stalls by visiting <http://www.changingleadsequinerescue.org/Events.html>. First paid, first reserved, no refunds. Stalls are set up on arena dirt, no shavings allowed. You **MUST clean your stall** before you leave. **Strictly enforced.**

Proof of Negative Coggins test (12 months) required per Missouri regulations. Concessions on site. Bleachers available for spectator seating. Portable restrooms available. Follow directions for parking. No RV hookups. **No stallions.** Judge's decision is final. Rules will follow AQHA guidelines. Any rules in question will have a decision made by the show committee. Ages calculated as of January 1, 2012. Attire is casual, but at a minimum, long pants and boots must be worn. Warm winter clothing welcome! English classes are for hunt seat OR saddle seat. Both stock-type and saddle-type horses welcome. Riders in Beginner Walk-Whoa classes can have a helper/leader assist. Changing Leads/American Royal are not responsible for ANY injury, escape, loss or death. Under Missouri Law, an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
