

Fuzzy Horse Show High Point Rules

- High-point awards will be tallied on each rider. It does not matter which horse you show.
- Changing Leads Equine Rescue has the right to determine what prizes are given away for high point.
- In each class that counts towards high point, the point breakdown is as follows: First place – 6 points. Second place – 5 points. Third place – 4 points. Fourth place – 3 points. Fifth place – 2 points. No place (scratches do not count) – 1 point. Ties will be broken by the number of first places, then the number of second places, and so on.
- High Point rider for each show receives a prize. Prize must be picked up immediately following the show, if not, it will be donated to Changing Leads Equine Rescue.
- Reserve High Point rider for each show receives a prize. Prize must be picked up immediately following the show, if not, it will be donated to Changing Leads Equine Rescue.
- High Point rider in each division for all shows receives a buckle and a prize bag.
- Reserve High Point rider in each division for all shows receives a bridle bag and a prize bag.
- Third place through Fifth place high point rider in each division for all shows will receive a prize bag.
- High Point riders (places first through fifth) in each division for all shows will receive their awards immediately following the conclusion of the final show in the series. If you won a prize and are not there to pick it up (or made arrangements to have someone pick it up for you), your prize will be donated to Changing Leads Equine Rescue.
