**OVERALL HI POINT AWARDS 13 & Under and 14-18:** A **trophy saddle** will be awarded to the horse/rider combination that achieves the greatest number of points based on the scale listed below. Ties will be broken using AQHA rules for All-Around Champion awards.

Each horse/rider combination placing in the Top 10 will receive a point for each entry they place above plus 1 point. Example: Class of 22 1st=23 points 2nd=22 points 3rd=21 points, etc.
