

IRISH FOX STABLES HORSE SHOW

COGGINS TESTS must be presented to the secretary before numbers are issued. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to show proof of test to be eligible to compete. **HARD HATS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED. ALL RIDERS MUST WEAR PROTECTIVE HARNESS.** Proper attire includes britches and hard soled shoes. Polo shirts may be worn.

CHAMPIONSHIPS AND RIBBONS: Six ribbons will be awarded in each class.

Championship and reserve ribbon will be awarded to the top two horses in each hunter division.

STALLS CALL (636.398.6868) FOR RESERVATIONS OR INDICATE ON YOUR PRE-ENTRY FORM. Move in is available at 9am on Thursday, schooling 12pm. Stalls are \$85 for the show, there are no one day stalls nor is jump outs (working out of the trailer) allowed at the NEC. If tack stalls are to be split a list needs to be presented to the office detailing to whom and how much. If such a list is not presented the tack room(s) will be split equally among the horses in your barn. All horses must have a stall. Move in time 12noon on Thursday.

PARKING: Ample parking in designated areas. Unload and park vehicles as soon as possible to eliminate congestion in the barn areas. **DO NOT PARK IN THE FIRE LANE, YOU WILL BE TOWED AT YOUR EXPENSE.**

ADDING AT THE GATE: Due to the extreme number of entries made at the gate and the difficulty collecting said fees this service will no longer be offered at this show. Any post entries made after the class sheets are distributed an add slip is required from the secretary...**NO EXCEPTIONS!! ADDS AND SCRATCHES ARE NOT RECOGNIZED UNTIL PAPERWORK IS FILLED OUT IN THE OFFICE AND GIVEN TO THE SECRETARY FOR PROCESSING.** No adjustment to the bill will be made if scratches are not settled in the office before it closes at the end of the show.

A SIGNED RELEASE AND A CURRENT COGGINS TEST NEEDS TO BE PRESENTED BY ALL HORSES ON THE PROPERTY BEFORE SCHOOLING. Any horse on the property not showing must register with the secretary. A \$30 non-showing fee will be charged in addition to the required office fee, and stall fee with shavings.

CHECK WITH THE MANAGEMENT FOR ASSIGNED STALLS.

Anyone in an unassigned stall may be asked to move and pay a \$25 clean up charge.

SHAVINGS: CALL 636.561.8080. Initial bedding is not included. All shavings orders and payments will be handled at the concessions window and no deliveries after **5pm.** ALL SHAVINGS MUST BE PURCHASED THRU THE NEC. NO SHAVINGS MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE PREMISES PER NEC RULES, a minimum of 2 per bags per stall is mandatory. **Anyone bringing in their own shavings or straw will be charged \$25 per stall clean up fees.**

SCHOOLING: Schooling in Arena A will be allowed Thursday 12 noon. Schooling in the eves is available until 9pm. Schooling is available in the AM until 7:30am,
