

POINT SYSTEM

Points will be given in the following classes provided two shows in the circuit have the class. To be eligible for annual awards, a equidae, or equitation rider/rider must have shown in at least two shows. Each owner/exhibitor will pay nomination, and membership fees, per equidae, equitation rider/rider, and riders showing nominated horses

(In order for points to count, Nominated Horses, Owners, and All Riders must be members), per class, per year, for points to count toward year-end Pony Express Horse Show Circuit.

Awards. Points will count from the date of nomination. No refunds.

Classes in which a horse is eligible for the Senior Division High Point award are those not designated by an asterisk (*).

Classes in which a horse is eligible for the Junior Division High Point award are those designated by an asterisk (*).

Those eligible to show in the Junior Division are exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday by December 1 of the current year.

It is extremely important that exhibitors keep track of their points on the Point Record form and turn it in to the Point Recorder so that all points can be checked for accuracy. Return to Point Record by November 15th.

To qualify for year-end awards you must Show in Two (2) Pony Express shows. Equestrian Disability classes are excluded from this requirement.

Each nominated exhibitor or equidae shall be awarded 1 point for being entered, shown, and judged in a class. This is a qualifying point.
