- Plantation Class—Walk & running walk, light or heavy shod. Max 8" shank on bridle, tack optional, no pads (including wedge pads). No canter.
- Youth Walk-Trot (13-18 yrs) English or Western tack/attire acceptable
- 10. Open English Pleasure-English tack/attire required
- 11. PeeWee Youth Poles (18 & under)
- 12. Adult Poles (Riders 19 & under)

- Adult Walk-Trot (19 & over) English or Western tack/attire acceptable

- PeeWee Youth Western Pleasure (18 & under) -Western tack/attire required
- 21. Light Shod Country Pleasure Walk & favorite gait. Max 3/8" x 3/4" shoe, max 8" shank on bridle, English or Western tack & attire required
- Open Western Pleasure (+\$100) Western tack/ attire required
- 23. Open Gaited Pleasure (+\$100)
- 24. Open Ranch Horse Rail Walk-Trot Class shows horse's ability to move at working speed w/rider. Horses will be shown at walk, trot, reverse, stop, & back. Judge will ask for extended trot at least one direction. Open to all breeds of equines that can perform a four-beat walk & two beat trot.
- 25. Open Ranch Horse Rail Pleasure Class shows the horse's ability to move at working speed with rider. Horses will be shown at walk, trot, canter, reverse, stop, & back. Judge will ask for extended trot at least one direction and may ask for extended canter. Class open to all breeds of equines that can perform a four-beat walk, twobeat trot, and three-beat canter.
- 26. Egg & Spoon (all ages)
- 27. Open Flag



- All classes are JACKPOT with 50/50 payout—Money paid for top three places, ribbons for top five places
- \$5 entry fee for all classes except Open Barrels, Open Western, and Open Gaited Pleasure \$10 entry fee for added money classes (Open Barrels, Open Western, and Open Gaited Pleasure)
- Leadline Class (7 & Under) pays top five places with an award for all participants
- No advanced entries, registration on site
- Negative Coggins required on ALL equine—must be presented at registration

1. No riding of stallions by youth exhibitors on grounds during show. 2. Ponies 56" & under measurement must be taken & entered on file prior to showing. 3. No entering ring at a run for any class. 4. Disqualification: Hitting in front of saddle. 5. Five second penalty for each barrel knocked down, two second penalty for each pole knocked down. 6. Three minute tack changes must be registered for classes two classes prior. 7. Judges decisions are final. 8. Proper attire and boots required for all classes. 9. Horse/Rider must be registered for classes two classes prior. 10. No cross entering in any halter class. 11. Age requirement as of Jan1. Additional Information: We reserve the right to hire and use qualified Veterinarians, DQP's or Farrier's to check for unsoundness.
