High Point: One highpoint and reserve high point ribbon will be awarded at the conclusion of the show to the horse/rider combination who accumulate the most amount of points throughout the day. In order to be eligible for the high point award, riders must enter their horse into a halter class and or a showmanship class. All classes will count towards the end of the day high point award. Riders wanting to go for the highpoint award must declare so on their entry forms.
