CEDAR VALLEY RIDERS FUN SHOW SERIES 2020

RULES:

- **THESE ARE FUN SHOWS.** The goal is to learn with your horse and grow as a rider and horseman throughout the year while having fun. Good sportsmanship will be expected from everyone on the grounds.
- These are equine only fun shows
- Class Divisions -(Breakdown, unless noted differently for the class) Age as of Jan. 1, 2020
 - Lead Line - Beginner rider and Therapeutic- Walk Trot
 - 8 and Under Walk Trot
 - Open Walk Trot- Beginner rider over 8 or green horse
 - 18 and Under- Walk, trot, lope
 - Adult 19 and Up- Walk, trot, lope
- If you are entered in a walk trot class, you will be placed at the bottom of the class in judged classes and receive a 30 second penalty in timed classes for riders who lope three strides in walk trot classes.
 - ** One person may not enter a walk trot class and use the same horse in a walk trot lope class the same show. You may not enter the lead line division and enter any other division in the same show.
 - ***A rider may only cross enter divisions if they are riding different horses in the divisions (for example adult class on one horse and open walk trot/green horse on a different horse)
- There is not a dress code, but participants must have on jeans and boots; button down long sleeve shirts and a hat are not required but may affect the judge's decisions for the judged classes
- The member prices ONLY apply to already approved members, applying the day of the show does not earn you the member discounts
- The family discount allows entry for the entire show.
- To earn the family discount you MUST be immediate family members, does not apply to groups or friends.
- The judge's decision is final, there will be 5 placing awarded with ribbons in all classes including lead line. The class will be placed all the way out for all persons in the class so that points can be accumulated to for year end awards for members.
- Patterns for classes requiring them and additional information will be posted on the Cedar Valley Riders Fun Show Series Group on Facebook before the shows. (Showmanship, Horsemanship, Reining)
- ***Patterns may be adjusted the day of the show at the judge's discretion***
- Discipline rail is similar to western pleasure mixed with simon says. You will be asked to perform random action and will be judged on the speed and quality of execution. Actions may but are not limited to, turn left 180°, lope, walk, back one stride, etc.

- Splish Splash will be for the lead line and 8 and under class only, entries will have to hold a cup of water while they ride around the pen, going through the maneuvers as they are called out and the one with the most water in the cup at the end of the class wins
- Team Tissue Race will have a section of tissue paper between two riders and the riders must ride together and cross the timeline, both must go around a barrel and cross back across the timeline. If the tissue breaks it is a no time. Any age may enter with a walk trot rider, again safety first. Lead Line both horses must be led.
- Bribe a horse will be out of the saddle. The contestant will be given a treat or is allowed to supply their own treat. The contestant will start before the timer line and use the treat attempting to 'bribe' the horse up into the center of the arena to a barrel. The contestant will then go around the top of the barrel and back. The fastest time will win. Leadline contestants may have a helper.
- The Backing Race, the contestant will start at the end of the arena. The rider will then run towards the marked line, stop, and back their horse as quickly as they can till they pass the timer line. The fastest time wins. Leadline must be led.
- Simon says involves bringing the whole class into the arena. The announcer will then alternate commands in an attempt to confuse the riders. Just like the in-person challenge. Once a rider fails the challenge they will move into the center. The last person in the class will win. Leadline must be led.
- The Scurry Race involves three elevated bars. The rider will begin on one side of the arena and make their way along the rail over the three elevated logs. If the horse knocks over the bar they will receive a 2 second penalty for every one knocked over. If the horse avoids the step the contestant is DQ from the class.
- Water Race Place a barrel about 1/3 of the way into the arena, the other about the middle. Put 3 large cups of water on the first barrel, coffee can on second barrel. Rider runs to first barrel, picks up the cup of water, runs to the second barrel, and empties water into can. Repeats process till all cups are empty. The fastest time wins, leadline must be led.
- Candy Bar Race the rider will have to cross the timeline and go around a barrel and grab the candy off the top of the barrel and go back across the timeline.
- Flag race will be Little Britches Rodeo pattern -*Not traditional Flags*- Rider will have a flag in their hand when they enter the pen and will have to place it in one bucket and ride around to the second barrel and pick up the second flag and ride across the timeline.
- **The September Ranch Show:** This year we will hold one special show on **September 19th**. We will switch the standard judged classes (Horsemanship/Pleasure/Reining/Discipline) to ranch related classes. Ranchmanship, Ranch Riding, and Trail. These classes will be very similar to their classic counter parts but what the judge looks for will be different.
 - Ranchmanship will consist of a patterned class where the judge will focus more on the horses control and versatility as well as the rider's ability to control the animal.
 - Ranch riding will be very similar to western pleasure meaning the riders will be asked to perform rail work. Ranch riding will be judged less on comfort but more on the usefulness and control of the animal.
 - Ranch trail will be a set pattern where the rider will have to control the horse through different varying tasks. The judges will place depending on control of the horse as well as the horses willingness to perform said tasks. A total of 7 obstacles will be used.

- Required:
 - Opening and closing gate
 - Dismount, ground tie, lift all feet, remount
 - drag a log (grab a rope tied to a log and pull it to a marked line)

****AS A MEMBER OF CEDAR VALLEY RIDERS SADDLE CLUB****

- If you attend 3 shows you will be eligible for year end awards. We will have awards for everyone who participated in two shows. There will be high point awards given to the high point in each division and additional prizes as the year's income allows. Prizes will increase in quality and quantity the more participation and money generated throughout the year including sponsorships
- All members are automatically entered in high point once they attend three CVR shows. Points will be awarded by place in each class with first place being worth 6 points and 5th place being 2 pts. All riders will receive 1pt for participation unless scratched or removed from the class.
- The rider will earn the points from their overall highest scoring horse/rider combo per division per show.
- Please refrain from bringing foals- if necessary, make sure they are haltered to lead
- There will be no horses tied in the entry and exit gate areas, and ask that you do not hold horses by the gate during classes either. Find a place to tie or hold horses not in the class entering or exiting the arena out of the way, this will help shows run smoother and be safer for all participants.
- Dogs need to be on a leash
- This is a great place for people of all ages and experience levels to come and enjoy friendships old and new! We want to make sure that this is possible at each and every show.
 - If a rider is unable to control their horse or it is a danger to others in a class, you may be excused from the class. If the behavior continues outside of the arena show staff may excuse you from the grounds.
 - As horsemen we will experience all types of riders, Equine (Mares, Stallions etc.), and lots of uncalculated events and obstacles. We understand that things happen, but still wish to keep the safety of all in mind.

We look forward to a fun year and watching growth in everyone and their horses!
