All rules apply to each day of the show

- 18 and under walk trot riders may cross enter into any lope/canter classes. However, 19 and over W/T may not compete in lope/canter classes unless specified, or unless in a buckle challenge class.
- Walk/Whoa riders 10 & under, are not eligible for jog or lope classes Saturday. However, they may show walk trot on Sunday. Both days, they may show with a handler or independently.
- Any horse/rider combo may show two handed if they are in a snaffle.
- Anyone may enter in a buckle challenge class regardless of age, division, or what classes they are competing in- anything goes, but all tack must be legal.

High Point Divisions and Qualifying Classes for Saturday

***Everyone running for a Saturday highpoint must enter in one halter class of their choice (classes 15-21)

Halter to be used as a tiebreaker for high point and not towards the highpoint rankings.

Rider 19 and Over W/T: 24, 31, 34, 38, 46, 51, 54, 62 Highpoint award and ribbon

No Highpoint for Sunday

Class #74 Discipline Showmanship: All exhibitors will compete simultaneously as a rail class (slightly off the rail), performing all maneuvers that the judge may call for, including walk, jog, extended jog, halt, back, pivots, setups.

Class #97 Blind Horsemanship: Riders will face the wall, and the pattern will not be distributed prior to the class starting. One at a time, each rider will have 60 seconds to look at the printed pattern to memorize it and then perform it. Competitors cannot watch other competitors as they ride the pattern.

Class #102 and #103 Ultimate Horse Challenge: This will be a timed pattern class. Exhibitors will lead (102) or ride (103) their horse through colored cones specified in the pattern. Other obstacles may include, but are not limited to: bridge, mailbox, pole, slicker. Think of this as timed trail, but instead of going over a multitude of poles you are going through cones. Have fun!

Ten second penalty: Unable to get a single foot on the bridge, inability to pick up slicker, or inability to open the mailbox.

Five second penalty: Each refusal of obstacle or maneuver. Not all four feet making it onto the bridge. Missing one of the cones that you need to go through.

Three second penalty: Each cone knocked.

Disqualified: Off pattern entirely by not attempting the correct obstacle in the correct order.

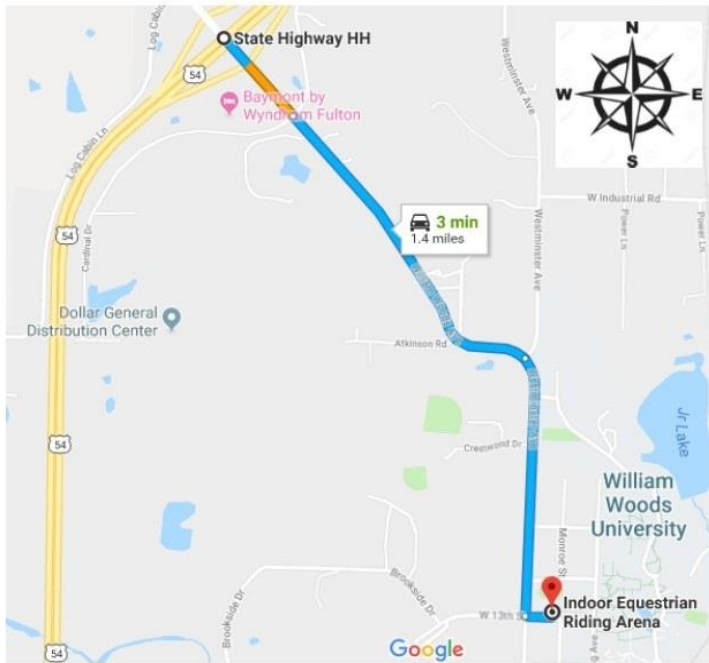
