No Highpoint for Sunday

Class #78 Discipline Showmanship: All exhibitors will compete simultaneously as a rail class (slightly off the rail), performing all maneuvers that the judge may call for, including walk, jog, extended jog, halt, back, pivots, setups.

Class #103 Blind Horsemanship: Riders will face the wall, and the pattern will not be distributed prior to the class starting. One at a time, each rider will have 60 seconds to look at the printed pattern to memorize it and then perform it. Competitors cannot watch other competitors as they ride the pattern.

Ultimate Horse Challenge: This is a timed pattern class. Exhibitors will lead (106) or ride (107) their horse through colored cones specified in the pattern.

Ten second penalty: Unable to get a single foot on the bridge or inability to open the mailbox, take the mail out of and back into the mailbox, failure to close the mailbox.

Five second penalty: Each refusal of obstacle or maneuver. 1 or more legs not going onto the bridge or stepping off the bridge to the side with one or more feet. Missing one of the cones that you need to go through.

Three second penalty: Each cone knocked or stepped on. 1 or more legs not going over a pole.

Disqualified: Off pattern entirely by not attempting the correct obstacle in the correct order.
